This course focuses on how to setup the Employee Self-Service user on Lawson System Foundation 9.0, including where to locate and populate user information such as the checks value, SSOP login and password, Security Roles, Employee Agent Company, and Employee ID assignment, as well as working with the Portal Role and Portal bookmarks all relative to the Employee Self-Service user on 9.0 Technology.

EDI Invoice Processing and Troubleshooting, 8.x (EDIINVPROC)

This course provides information on setting up and processing EDI Invoices. Topics include how to set up EDI Invoice Processing, how to use the Invoice Interface (MA540), and tips for troubleshooting problems.

Lawson S3 System Foundation

Access Lawson Data (ACCESSDATA)

This course introduces the different tools available to reference database tables, field names, field descriptions, numbers, system codes, and relationships in numerous Lawson development environments. You will learn what database files and/or field names you need, as well as the various types of data connection that can be made with Lawson data, and when using one type is more appropriate than another. If you aren't currently using the Lawson technology described above, you can benefit from the introduction to Lawson database structure and file/field naming conventions.

Build a Dashboard (BUILDDASH)

Dashboards link your data to a single click on a web page. This course explains the process of building a dashboard, including adding modules, searching for data in the Lawson EPM applications, and the display options available.

Cross Tabs for Crystal Repots, XI (CRYXICRSTAB)

This course covers the functions of Cross Tabs and demonstrates their use with Crystal XI. You will learn how to build a Cross Tab and how to use Cross Tabs for analysis.

Plan for Lawson Security - Authorization (SECAUTH90)

This “roles and rules-based” architecture system provides a powerful, flexible security platform. Its focus on business process will exactly match the Lawson application security requirements with the way your organization operates. In this overview class you will explore the authorization engine, preview rule writing examples and results, and learn how to prepare for this security system.

System Foundation 9.0 Administration: Portal Administration (INTROPTL90ADM)

This course, which focuses on basic tasks for Lawson Portal Administration, highlights the 9.0 Portal File Structure. You’ll learn how to set up a user with administrative rights, define portal roles and groups, and how to work with bookmarks and hotkeys on Portal 9.0.

System Foundation 9.0: Implementing Lawson Security, 9.0 (WILS90)

This course focuses on planning for Lawson Security on Lawson System Foundation 9.0. It addresses the various stages of establishing security for Lawson Applications and Environment, including Project Analysis, Training, Security Analysis, Security Modeling, Proof of Concept, Lawson Security Build, and Test.

Friday, December 18 9:00-10:00 a.m.

System Foundation 9.0 Administration: LAUA User and Group Security (SYSADM9LAUASEC)

This course focuses on user setup and authorization on System Foundation 9.0 specific to LAUA. The flexibility of 9.0 Technology allows for two different security systems. A user can be secured using Lawson’s legacy security system, LAUA, or by Lawson Security 9.0. Clients can utilize both systems and may have some users secured by LAUA and some secured by Lawson Security 9.0. This course covers the various components of the user record in Resource Management and user set up in LAUA, including User Group, Jobqueue Group, and Printer Group creation and assignment.
